HQS SUPPORT





HQS can receive full AEB support (additional clarifications, updates etc

More than 2000 re-entry rights for HQS & their family members during the pandemic

Daily communication with the migration authorities

Our achievements:

Beginning on 2021 – **multiple entry permission** for HQS and family members

14 days **quarantine abolishment** for HQS

Daily support on numerous migration issues: entry permission, QR codes for foreigners etc

End of 2021 – foreign employees **medical testing procedure easing**

2022 – maintaining HQS legal status


