- The AEB was **founded** in **1995** on the initiative of a number of European companies that operated in Russia, Ambassadors of EU member countries and the head of the European Commission's Representative Office in the Russian Federation.
- The AEB is an active community of more than 500 member companies from the member states of the EU, the European Free Trade Association (EFTA) and other countries, which have business activities with and in the Russian Federation.
- The AEB is an advocate of its members' opinion, generated in over **60 industrial** and cross-sectoral committees, subcommittees and working groups.





HOW TO BECOME AN AEB MEMBER

Admittance of new members is based on a written application and settled by the AEB Board. The membership fee is determined by the worldwide annual turnover of the company (in Euros).

SPONSOR	n/a	12.000	12 assigned members / 2 representatives free access to paid events & top events; free access to all open events & respective committee meetings, etc.
CATEGORY A	>500	6.500	8 assigned members / 1 representative to the top events; free access to all open events & respective committee meetings, etc.
CATEGORY B	100–499	4.000	5 assigned members / 1 representative to the top events; free access to all open events & respective committee meetings, etc.

CATEGORY R (rep. offices)	n/a	3.000	Company represented in Russia by a rep office only may join in category R for the <u>first 2 years</u> ; then in category B for the <u>3rd year</u> ; upgrade to category A for the <u>4th year</u> if applicable. 3 assigned members / 1 representative to top events, free access to all open events & respective committee meetings
