GENERAL INFORMATION


- The Association of European Businesses (AEB) is the main representative body of foreign investors in the Russian Federation.



HOW TO BECOME AN AEB MEMBER



Admittance of new members is based on a written application and settled by the AEB Board. The membership fee is determined by the worldwide annual turnover of the company (in Euros).

CATEGORY R (rep. offices)	n/a	3.000	Company represented in Russia by a rep office only may join in category R for the <u>first 2 years</u> ; then in category B for the <u>3rd year</u> ; upgrade to category A for the <u>4th year</u> if applicable. 3 assigned / 1 representative to top events, free access to all open events & respective committee meetings
