AALEXANDER SITNIKOV DISCUSSES THE USE OF TECHNICAL INDICATORS FOR MAKING DEALS ON OIL AND REFINED PRODUCT MARKETS

On September 17, 2015, the VEGAS LEX law firm took part in the Moscow workshop and conference, *Global and Local Oil Product Markets in Today's Economy: Analysis, Forecasting and Pricing*, held as part of the preparation for the Third National Oil and Gas Forum*.

Managing Partner <u>Alexander Sitnikov</u> spoke at the session devoted to the analysis of the current situation and the main trends in the motor fuel markets in Russia and the CIS, *Petroleum Product Markets in Russia and the CIS in Today's Economic Environment*.

The participants also discussed the current oil market situation, the supply and demand trends, a medium term market forecast, and other key issues.
