ROUND TABLE "REMOTE SECURITY AS ONE OF THE MOST DYNAMIC TYPE OF PRIVATE SECURITY. TENDENCIES AND PERSPECTIVES".

On February 10, 2015 the Association of European Businesses in co-operation with the international exhibition operator "Messe Frankfurt" held within the frames of TB Forum powered by Intersec a roundtable "Remote security as one of the most dynamic type of non-governmental security. Tendencies and perspectives". The roundtable was attended by over 80 experts from different regions of Russia.

The moderator of the roundtable, Mikhail Balev (Chairman of Security Subcommittee of the AEB Safety, Health, Environment and Security Committee; Business Development Executive of MIG Business Security Strategies) specified a number of hot aspects of the remote security industry in Russia. The participants of the round table expressed their concerns that in some regions of Russia local licensing authorities ban private security organizations to use subcontracts for providing remote security services, citing the allegedly existing legislative restrictions. Meanwhile, subcontracting scheme of interaction is functionally and economically efficient, especially for the clients who have their own facilities, distributed over a wide area. The analysis of this issue made by the lawyers at the request of Security Subcommittee allows to acknowledge legitimate (in accordance with the current legislation of the Russian Federation) the right of private security enterprises to use subcontractors if the contract with the customer contains the provision that the service provider can delegate the fulfillment of an obligation to the third parties (subcontractors). In this case, the validity of subcontracting fully comply with the provisions of the Civil Code of the Russian Federation, in particular Article 706, and the provisions of the Law «On private detective and security activities in the Russian Federation», in particular Article 7 and Article 9, where there is no restriction that the private security organization, that concluded a contract with a customer for security services providing, should to be the executor of these services.

The participants of the roundtable had the opportunity to listen to the reports of Nikolay Nikolaev, senior researcher of the Research center "Security", Ministry of Internal Affairs of the RF; Vladimir Lipov, marketing director of Altonika SB; Dmitry Taranenko, commercial director of Altonika SB; Alexey Ilyin, Chairman of board, «FARB» Group of Companies (Ioshkar-Ola), coordinator of MOP «Center» for Volga Federal District; and Vasily Volkovitskiy, Technical Director of CJSC «Honeywell».

A lively discussion followed the reports on use of different types of information transmission systems (ITS) since this issue significantly impacts the reliability and cost of security services. The participants of roundtable agreed that even with the rapid development of new technologies and the widespread
