International forum Digital Production – consolidates industry developers and solutions-providing companies, chief-executives from Ministry of Industry and Trade of the Russian Federation, Ministry of Telecom and Mass Communications of the Russian Federation and CEOs from Russian major producing companies, which realize a conversion to Industry 4.0. Forum main topics: Strategies of digital production, Automation, Economic effect of IT-technologies integration, Cybersecurity, Big Data in production.
