

ROSAVTODOR METHODOLOGY DOCUMENTS AND THEIR APPLICATION IN INVESTMENT PROJECTS IN RUSSIAN REGIONS

The participants of a RADOR-sponsored workshop discussed the practice of attracting non-government investment to regional road development projects; Head of PPP and infrastructure practice Denis Shtirbu spoke at the event.

On February 25, 2016, Head of PPP and infrastructure practice of VEGAS LEX [Denis Shtirbu](#) spoke at the first plenary meeting of the workshop *The practice of attracting non-government investment to the public road system of Russian regions*, organized by the Russian Association of Regional Road Administrations (RADOR).

The expert focused on the package of the Federal Road Agency's (Rosavtodor) methodology documents and their application in investment projects in Russian regions. Mr. Shtirbu spoke in detail about the purpose, structure and content of the methodologies, analyzed their relevance in the current market situation, and gave a comparative analysis of their application in the context of the [private concession initiative](#).

The participants also discussed the use of the private concession initiative mechanism in investment projects in the road sector, the prospects and trends in implementing regional road projects, the advantages and disadvantages of [concession agreements](#) and lifecycle contracts ([LCC](#)) in the implementation of road projects, and other issues.
