




HUMAN RIGHTS SITUATION AS COMPARED WITH 2-3 YEARS AGO






STATISTIC BORDERS OF THE RUSSIAN NGO'S SECTOR

- Total number of non-governmental non-commercial organizations in the Russian Federation is about 360 000 (Governmental agency Rosstat)
- Only 38% registered NGO's are really operating (about 136 000)


STRUCTURE OF THE RUSSIAN NGO'S SECTOR




BASIC DIRECTIONS OF THE NGO'S ACTIVITIES
