












## Data Protection – 7 good practices

Processing of personal data shall always follow the ROCKWOOL Group Privacy Principles, so

Inform people about your processing.

Use data only for the intended purpose.

Collect only the necessary data.

Jpdate and check the quality of personal data

Delete all data when no longer necessary.

Keep personal data safe and secure

Document your use of personal data Have a legal basis – and tell what you are doing.

Adequate, relevant and limited to the necessary for the purpose

Kept no longer than necessary for the purpose

Demonstration of compliance. If it isn't documented, it isn't done.

Specified, explicit purpose. No incompatible further processing.
