



# Businesses will be restricted from using foreign words

On 28 February 2023, amendments\* to the Law on the State Language of Russia came into force, restricting the use of foreign words in a number of key areas. Since then, all companies operating on the Russian market must comply with the new requirements for the layout of foreign language texts. Eventually, the use of foreign words not approved by "official" dictionaries may be banned.
