### What are the challenges pushing back the development of the Russian market?

- There is no accurate information about the actual energy demand
- There is no incentive for the user to save energy
- The financial feasibility of energy efficiency measures can't be determined and investors are not ready to take risks
- Low energy prices in Russia discourage energy efficiency measures
- Energy providers are not interested in reducing the energy consumption
