

Festive Easter Brunches will be held at Hotel Baltschug Kempinski Moscow on 21 and 28 April

The Festive Easter Brunch will be held on 21 and 28 April from 12:30 to 16:30. Depending on the choice of beverages, the cost will be 8,900 roubles per person (including Ruinart champagne), 6,900 roubles per person (including Prosecco) or 5,500 roubles per person (including soft drinks). Special prices are provided for the youngest guests (2,500 roubles for children from 6 to 11 years old), and, as always, there will be no charge for children under six years old.
