

Ilya Sachkov

He graduated from the Department of Information Security of the Faculty of Informatics and Control Systems, Bauman Moscow State Technical University. Ilya Sachkov is the founder of Group-IB – Russian market leader in computer crime investigation and the winner of the RuNet Award 2013. Mr. Sachkov has headed the company since 2003.

He is a member of various professional associations, such as the International Information Systems Forensics Association (IISFA), the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners (ACFE), and HoneyNet Project – a leading international security research organization.

Mr. Sachkov is a member of the judging panel of the ZUBR Awards (an award for the strengthening of security in Russia), the Russian Information Systems Security Professional Association (RISSPA) and the Cybercrime Committee of the Russian Association for Electronic Communications (RAEC). He is a member of the cybercrime Expert Committees of the State Duma of the Russian Federation, the Council of Europe and the OSCE.

In 2010, Sachkov became the first Russian to win the Digital Crimes Consortium award for his contribution to international exchange of experience in the field of computer forensics. Since 2012, he has been a member of the Working Group of the Expert Advisory Board of the PIR Center on International Information Security and Global Internet Governance.
