CMS successfully defended GE Healthcare in a court of cassation against the Russian healthcare authority

Moscow, 1 February 2020 – CMS has successfully defended interests of GE Healthcare in the court of appeal and further in the court of cassation against the Russian healthcare regulatory authority (*Roszdrazhnadzor*), in the case we reported [earlier](#).

We could invalidate the regulator's refusal from registering one of GE Healthcare products, modern ultrasound diagnostic system, in Russia. The Arbitration Court of the Moscow District upheld the decisions of the lower instances and obliged the regulator to authorise the client's product and allow its circulation in Russia.
