










Appeal of Smart Home products





Unit cost of a smart devices








Number of smart devices @home








Number of Smart Homes, in Europe








Energy consumption in EU households

Definition of Smart Appliances



Always related to Demand Side Management:

Capable of automatically changing and optimising consumption patterns in response to external stimuli, with the aim to improve the environmental impact of energy use over the whole energy system

10 priorities

A reasonable and balanced free trade A new boost for jobs, growth agreement with the United States. and investment. A connected digital single market. An area of Justice and Fundamental Rights based on mutual trust. Towards a new policy on migration. A resilient Energy Union with a forward-looking climate change policy. A deeper and fairer internal market Europe as a stronger global actor. with a strengthened industrial base. A Union of democratic change. A deeper and fairer Economic and Monetary Union (EMU).

Market Design



- Electricity Market Regulation + Electricity Market Directive
- To update the European electricity market, for increased electrification + renewables
- Includes clear and consistent provisions to empower consumers to participate in residential demand side management → open for any actor
- Flexible demand must be granted the same rights as energy production >
 remove barriers to the roll-out of initiatives to exploit residential DSF
- Financial compensation at the real market value of the service provided
- Ownership and privacy of consumer data

Ecodesign for Smart Appliances



- Since 2014: preparatory study on Ecodesign for Smart Appliances
- New term: Energy Smart
- For appliances covered by existing Energy Labelling Regulation: Energy smart icon on the energy label if the product complies with the criteria for energy smart functionality
- For appliances covered by existing Ecodesign Regulation: Energy Smart icon attached if the product complies with the criteria of energy smart functionality
- Preliminary conclusions: more work is needed, before any measures

Interoperability





Interoperability = the capability of the appliance to interact with third parties to enable Demand Side Flexibility Use Cases

This definition is agreed within APPLiA and shared with all external stakeholders





Interoperability = **not** about giving others full control of the product!

- Manage home consumption with the least effort from the consumers' side
