Lidings Counsel speaks before AEB Legal Committee



Lidings' Counsel of dispute resolution practice Sergey Kislov will speak at the Association of European Business Legal Committee meeting that is scheduled to take place at the AEB office in Moscow on March 12th, 2014.

The meeting will be devoted to the legal review and analysis of recently proposed regulatory and legislative enactments that may impact AEB's members gathering representatives of the legal departments from various commercial entities operating in Russia, as well as lawyers from national and international law firms, members of the Committee, to discuss the issues at full and share their expertise.

Invited by the Committee's coordinators to deliver a special presentation on the highly discussed issue of merging Russian Supreme Court and Russian Supreme Commercial Court Sergey will highlight key aspects of these two structures uniting such, as: premises of the merge, order of formation and mechanisms of operation of the new Supreme Court and possible consequences of this reform for foreign business.
