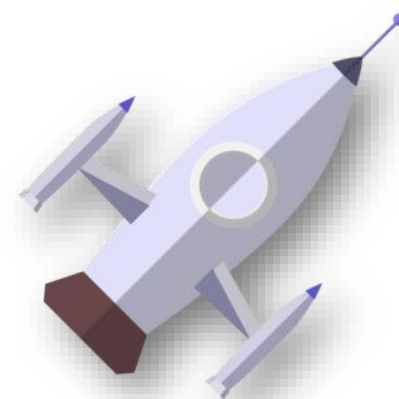

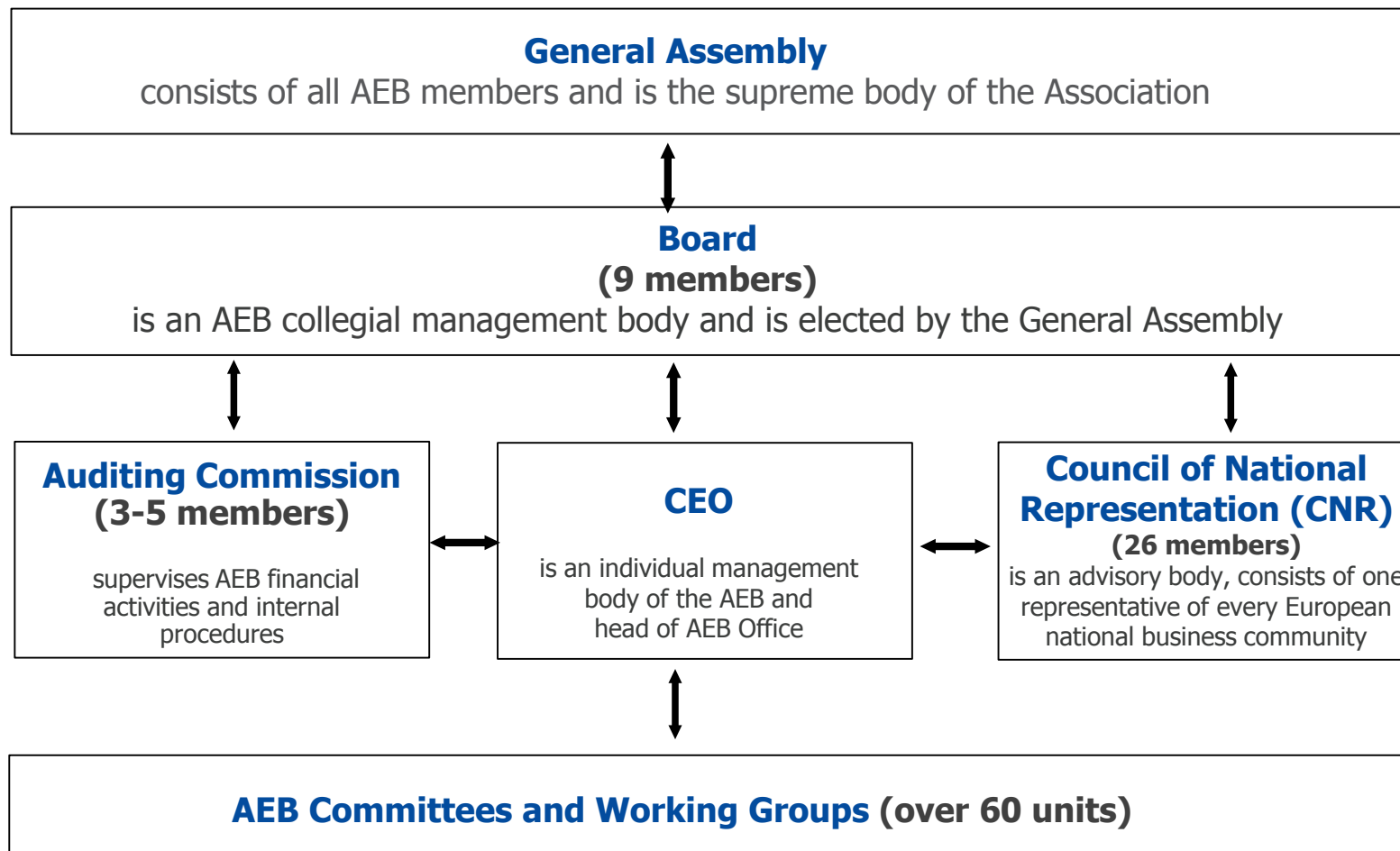

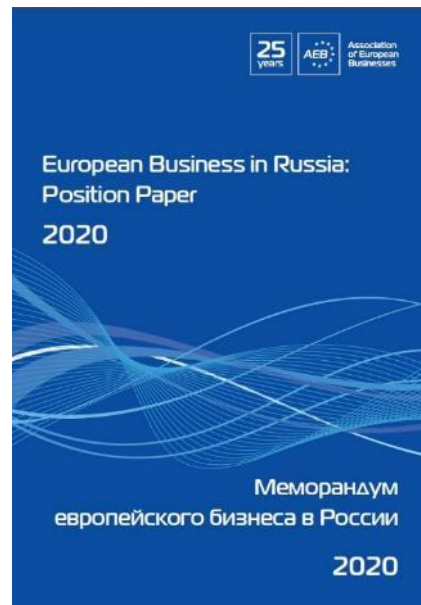

Admittance of new members is based on a written application and settled by the AEB Board. The membership fee is determined by the worldwide annual turnover of the company (in Euros).
